Tribals, districts of Karrimnagar at Allampalli and Beersaipet. Nethra Vidyalay, Blind School in Vizainagaram. And a Junior College, a Degree College for Blind (first in India) in Shamshabad. Vedic schools are established in Shamshabad, Jaggayyapet, Sithanagaram and Vizag. JET India also conducts health, eye camps, cancer awareness programs for detection and prevention in rural areas, and veterinary services. JET provides funds and services to those effected by nature calamities. Rebuilding/supporting ancient temples is also one of the major activities.

Students' Code of Conduct

- **Dress** for Students need to be appropriate since yoga is part of Prajna. Fancy pants, tops, dresses and jewelry are a distraction in the class. The pants should cover the knees.
- **Tilakam** (urdhva pundram) practicing to apply for every student is appreciated.
- **Punctuality:** Classes start on time, all students are expected to be in the class five minutes before the class. may not be permitted to the class 15 minutes after the class starts.
- **Do not litter** the classrooms, they should be left in the same condition they were prior to the class. Do not remove anything or disturb any items in the classroom or in Asramam.
- **Class Materials:** Bring Text books, note book and pen or pencil when you come to class.
- **No Food or Drink** is allowed in any of the classrooms or assembly area.
- **Shoes** should be left in lines at designated areas.
- **No Chewing Gums or Bubble Gums** are allowed anywhere on the Asramam premises.
- **Silence:** running or chatting loud is not allowed in the class rooms or in the hall ways.
- **Respect Teachers** and elders and be kind to all students.
- **Use Trash Cans** and dispose the trash properly.
- **Bathrooms** should be kept clean after every use.
- **Early Dismissal:** a note from parent is required.
- **Volunteering :** All Students over 10 years old get chance to do few services like - managing the shoe area, directing students to their classrooms etc.
- **Prasadam:** Students who also attend second hour classes are advised to take prasadam after the class at 12.30pm to avoid delays with their second classes.
- **Make Ups:** There are no make up classes for Prajna.

Parent Responsibilities

For the maximum benefit and to have the best learning experience for your child, parents are requested to follow these guidelines.

- **Registration** form must be completed with full info. and submit along with the fee before student commences.
- **Drop off and Pick up** the children at the front area.
- **Park** your cars in the designated areas only, not in front of the house.
- **Punctuality** must be maintained by all Parents for dropping and picking off children on Time. Please attend to your children until the teacher arrives.
- **Under 6 years old:** Must be accompanied by the parent in the classroom. All parents are allowed to sit in the classrooms with the Teacher's permission. But not allowed to interfere with the children.
- **Practice:** The secret for child's success depends upon the parent's participation. So, encourage your child to practice slokams, bhajans etc. every day and complete the homework, if any.
- **Absence:** If your child cannot attend the class due to any reason, please inform the child's teacher.
- **Volunteering Services** are encouraged to all parents in religious and social activities. Ex: book store, Parking, assisting teachers, keeping the premises clean, helping out during the events etc. When parents actively participate in services children also learn by observing parents.
- **Sponsoring Food** for students is shared by all the Prajna families. 2 to 4 families are required to prepare and serve food after the classes. You will be informed when your turn comes. Tasks involved are preparation, distribution, cleaning and taking away trash. More info. will be posted.
- **Prajna Teacher Training** is available for interested parents. Contact at 609- 297- 8797 for details.

JET New Jersey Policy for Prajna Classes

- **Safety:** JET USA Inc or JET New Jersey cannot and will not be responsible for the safety of the children outside classrooms. Parents are expected to escort the children after the class hours.
- **Prajna Material** can be purchased for a cost of \$35.00, if the child loses it . Child is not allowed in the classroom without the material.
- **Cancellation of the Classes** JET New Jersey reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient registrations or for any other reason. In such cases, the full amount will be refunded for those registered and paid.
- **Bad Weather:** due to severe weather warnings, classes may be cancelled. The Prajna families will be notified through emails. The information will be posted at our Website www.jetnewjersey.org.
- **Communications** are done through emails and our website www.jetnewjersey.org. Please make sure to provide us with your correct email and phone numbers, and inform us the changes asap.
- **Tardyness:** Students coming to class more than 15 minutes late will be considered as absent., and will not be allowed in the class.
- **Abnormal Behavior:** The management reserves the right to dismiss any student for failure to abide by the policies, after duly discussing with their parents.
- **Tests:** Mid term and End of the Year Tests will be conducted for all modules. The final test score includes 5% for attendance.
- **Family Involvement** is necessary for your students to learn many of our festivals and activities. Some of these festivals fall on weekends, Asramam schedule these celebrations during the class timings. That is the best opportunity for students to learn about our culture and practice what they are learning in the classrooms. Make a point to involve your children and expose them for these celebrations.
- **Please Do not ignore the email messages from JET NJ.**
